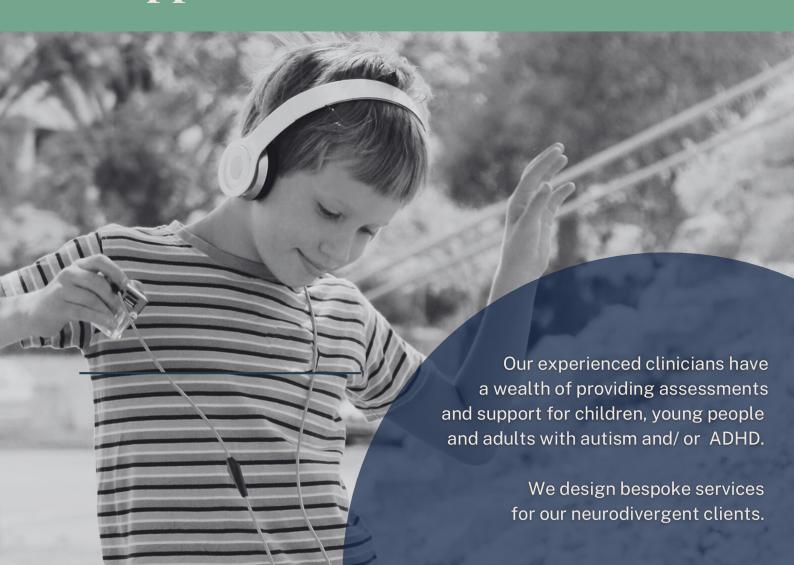

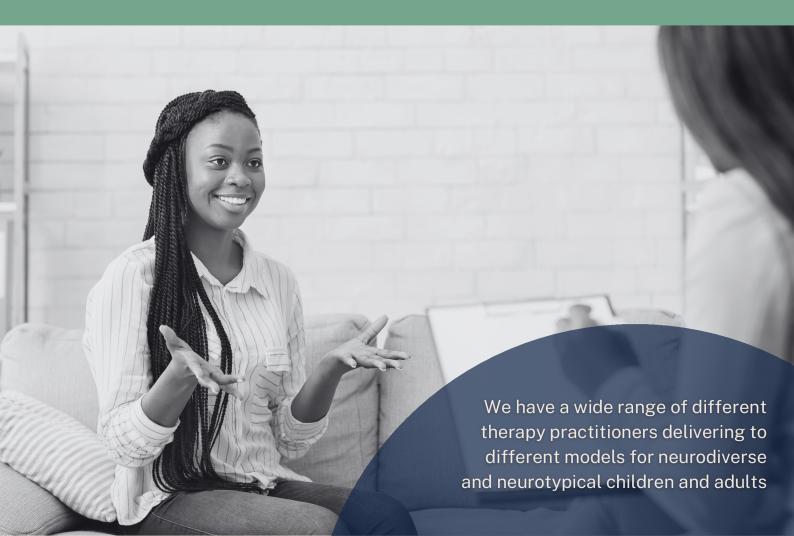

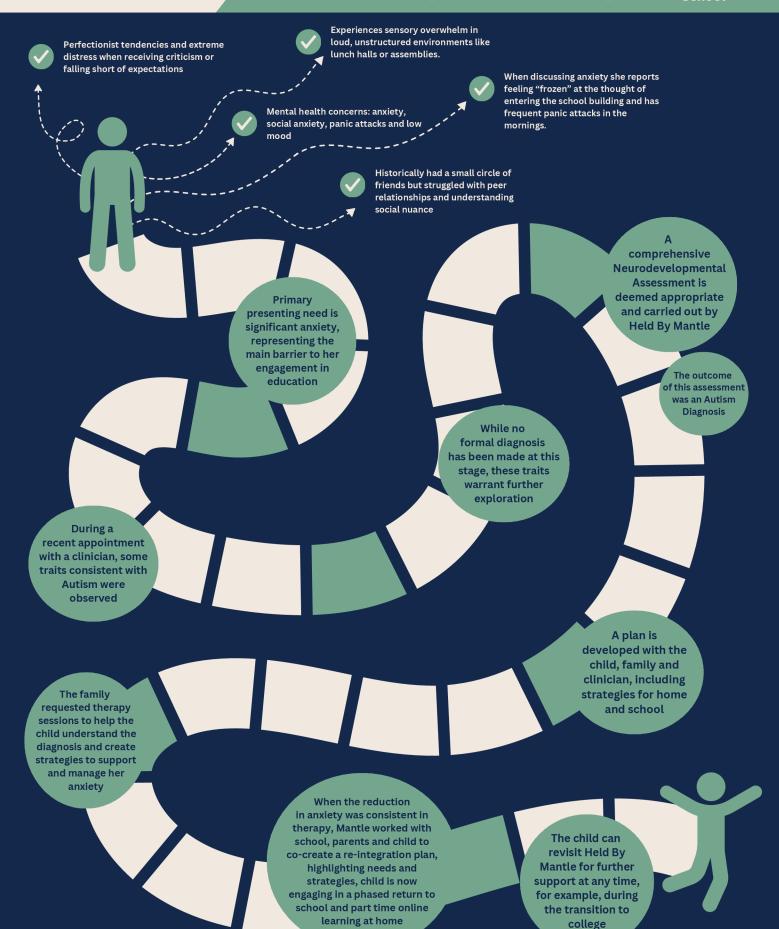

13 Years Old

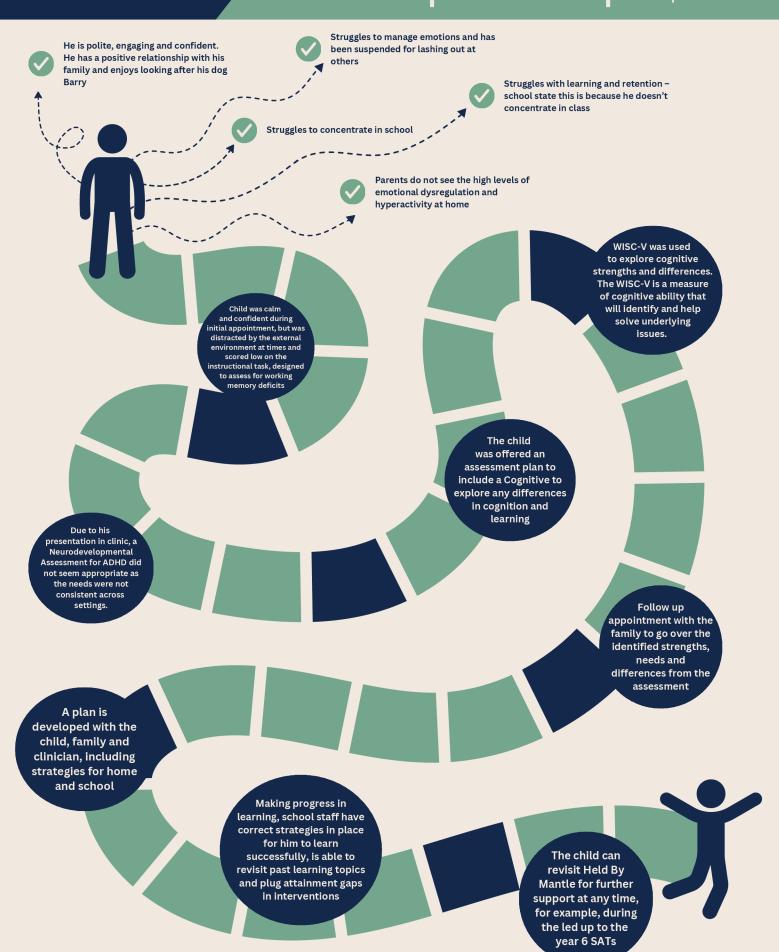
Mainstream High School High attainer with no additional needs identified in Primary School



Case Study Two Child B

Male 8 Years Old Mainstream
Primary School

Parents requested an ADHD assessment on initial point of contact



Limited social network. Admits to feeling isolated. Few close friendships due to demanding work schedule and

emotional withdrawal.

Self referred to therapy after experiencing persistent anxiety, difficulty sleeping, and a general sense of dissatisfaction with his life.

Reports frequent irritability, emotional numbness and trouble focusing at work. issues have intensified over the past 12 months, coinciding with his divorce and a change in job responsibilities.

Medication: None currently; has considered asking his GP for something to "help him calm down."

Trauma History: Reports verbal and emotional abuse from his father during childhood. No reported history of physical or sexual abuse.

Proposed plan of weekly 1 hour therapy sessions with Held By Mantle Working with
clinician on
techniques for
emotion regulation
(e.g., mindfulness,
grounding)

Provided with psychoeducation about anxiety and depression

Therapy
sessions to work
on cognitive
restructuring of
negative selfbeliefs

Set goals for therapy to reduce symptoms of anxiety and depression; Improve coping strategies for stress and emotional regulation; Develop communication skills for effective co-parenting

Exploration during therapy sessions of past trauma and its impact on current functioning

Supportive therapy to encourage re-engagement in social life

Reports reduction in anxiety and depression symptoms, reports an improved relationship with children and expartner, joined a social group and goes walking with them once a week
